During the last two years our district:

 Achieved ninety percent or above on our Annual Performance Report score - placing us in the category of Accreditation with Distinction.

• Increased student enrollment by nearly 10 percent.

Regarding the BUDGET – we focused our efforts on increasing student achievement even in a time of little to no growth in revenue. During the next few months, we will need to make reductions and/or re-allocations for the 2015-16 budget year.

Regarding school BOUNDARIES - a demographic study is underway to examine enrollment trends, corresponding facility needs, and indications for potential changes in school BOUNDARIES.
